Heating assistance is available

Georgia's regular Energy Assistance Program is open for homebound and frail elderly households. Also, households with individuals who have life-threatening medical conditions and have been disconnected or are in danger of being disconnected may apply. The program provides financial assistance to low-income elderly (age 65 and above) and disabled households to help defray their home heating costs.

Households participating in the program must meet income criteria and be

responsible for the cost of heating their homes. To be eligible, households must have an income equal to or less than 150 percent of the federal poverty guidelines: \$15,600 for a one-person household; \$21,000 for two persons; \$26,400 for three persons; \$31,800 for four persons; \$37,200 for five persons; \$42,600 for six persons; \$48,000 for seven persons and \$53,400 for eight or more persons.

Interested individuals or those who look after the interest of the elderly or

homebound individuals should call the Early County Neighborhood Service Center at 723-3190 or the Calhoun County Neighborhood Service Center at 725-1325 to place their name on the list. Clients will be assisted on a first come, first serve basis. It is not necessary to go the NSC, but it is necessary to call and get your name on the list for an appointment time for an application to be completed.

Applicants should have proof of income for all household members for the last 30

days. This may be a paycheck stub, or a letter granting public assistance, Social Security or unemployment benefits.

Applicants must also have the Social Security card of all household members and their most recent utility or fuel bill. Households whose fuel costs are included in the rent are ineligible for assistance.

If funds are available, the program will open to the general public on Dec. 1.

Eligible individuals should go to the Early County Neighborhood Service Center located at 1241 North Main Street in Blakely or the Calhoun County Neighborhood Service Center at 104 Maxwell Street in Arlington.
