 driver two or three minutes before he heard the shots.
 GBI agents are investigating the shooting. They interviewed other officers who were at the scene Monday and were scheduled to interview officer Kopkie Tuesday.

In addition to the Calhoun County officers, officers from Arlington and Edison had joined in the chase by the time Pierce wrecked.
 Agents will also process the truck for evidence and review vehicle video cam

footage which recorded the chase and crash.
 Pierce's body was sent to the crime lab in Atlanta, but GBI agents had not received any results.
 According to Calhoun County sheriff Josh Hilton, other than the fact that several empty

beer cans were found in the truck, officers have no idea why Pierce, a 1994 Calhoun County High graduate, led officers on the high speed chase.
 Pierce's older brother, Walt, is a member of the Edison city council.
